## **Nursery Programme Modules**

### **1. Pre Literacy:**

- Begins to listen in small or large groups
- Begins to listen in order to connect with others
- Begins to listen and respond to songs, stories
- Begins to speak in order to be understood
- Begins to use gestures, actions, body language and/or words to communicate needs and to express ideas and feelings

### **2. Pre Numeracy:**

- Explores with manipulatives
- Builds towers of 4 or more blocks
- Explores basic shapes
- Begins to understand that common language can be used to describe position and direction (e.g., inside, outside, above, below, next to, behind, in front of, up, down)
- Begins to collect objects
- Begins to develop an understanding of sequencing

### **3. Physical Literacy:**

- Begins to perform self-care skills independently when eating, dressing, toileting and washing hands
- Begins to show care for personal belongings
- Begins to demonstrate strength to perform gross-motor tasks
- Begins to demonstrate coordination and balance
- Begins to use hand-eye coordination to perform fine motor tasks with a variety of manipulative materials

### **4. Who we are:**

- Each person is unique and grows and changes in their own way with a subject focus on living things (science), social organization and culture (social studies), identity and interactions (personal and social)
- Begins to understand their body, how they grow and change
