Age Requirements

Documentation

Students who are new to the school must provide the relevant official documents to verify their prior schooling, if applicable, at the time of admission.

Students already in the school must successfully complete their current grade in order to move to the next grade level.

English Language Learner Requirements

Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 5 – N/A

Grade 6 – No entry requirement for August to December; minimum Phase 2 for January to June entry.

Immersion/Bilingual Programme Entry Requirements

Pre-Kindergarten : no language requirements

Junior Kindergarten to Grade 1 : native or near-native in English or Chinese

Students from Grades 2 to 5 may be required to take English and/or Chinese Proficiency assessment.

Grade 2 : native English or minimum Phase 2 English Language proficiency, and native Chinese or minimum stage 2 Chinese Language proficiency

Grade 3 : native English or minimum Phase 3 English Language proficiency, and native Chinese or minimum stage 3 Chinese Language proficiency.

Grade 4 : native English or minimum Phase 3 English Language proficiency, and native Chinese or minimum stage 4 Chinese Language proficiency.

Grade 5 : native or near native in both languages

Students in the ELL programme are instructed by ELL certified instructors for 10% to 40% of total instructional time. Students attend mainstream PYP classes for the remaining instructional time.
