1. From August 2020 at Lakeside only.
2. Equal exposure to both languages and fully aligned with the PYP. Entry requirements apply and classes are subject to enrolment. Grade 6 Chinese-English bilingual classes will be offered at Lakeside only in 21/22.
3. In 20/21, classes are offered in grades 2-5 only. From 21/22, grades 1 & 2 will be offered subject to the enrolment of 28 students per grade. This enrolment number must be met by 31 January 2020. Should we not meet these numbers, classes in grades 1 & 2 will not be offered in August 21, and parents who have applied will have the application fee refunded if they decide not to enrol at CIS. Grades 3-5 will be offered in 21/22.
4. Spanish is offered at Lakeside Campus only. Classes are subject to enrolment.
5. Chinese classes are subject to enrolment.
6. Language & Literature classes are offered in English, Chinese, and French, while Literature is only offered in English only. Over 55 IB approved self-taught languages are offered in the diploma programme - students in self-taught are supported by a CIS teacher/tutor in their study and will be eligible to graduate with a bilingual IB diploma.
7. IBDP languages are offered based on demand.
8. A wide range of languages are on offer to students of varying proficiency levels. Classes incur an additional fee and taught by external providers. Our admissions team can provide further details on what is on offer.
