- **Retrace the Route On Horse Back**

The Tea Horse Road witnessed the cultural and economic exchanges between ancient China and the world, possessing significant historical and cultural value. We will ride horses to retrace the routes, experiencing the cultural heritage and natural beauty.

- **Tea Culture Experience**

Experts will provide detailed explanations to children about the impact of the Tea Horse Trade on the tea culture of Yunnan's minority regions. They will also experience the frying and tasting tea, immersing themselves in the wisdom of tea culture.



- **Ancient Chinese Armor**

Students will explore the development of armor and its connection to the Tea Horse Road.

- **Hands On Experience**

Students will have the opportunity to craft their own armor, experiencing the wisdom of ancient artisans and the spirit of craftsmanship. The pieces they create will also serve as small gifts from their cultural journey, allowing them to take home a piece of their experience to cherish.



- **Baisha Ancient Town**

Visiting the ancient town of Baisha, students will gain insights about the Naxi ethnic group cultural background by witnessing its buildings and murals.

- **Dongba Script**

The Dongba script is considered a living fossil of world writing systems, being the only remaining logographic script. Students will learn about the techniques and artistic characteristics of Dongba calligraphy.

- **Naxi Bronze**

Students will learn about the process and tools used in the making of Naxi bronze art, then create their own bronze artifact by hand. Through this hands-on experience, they will appreciate the beauty and joy of bronze artistry, while also gaining insight into the spirit of craftsmanship.



- **Yulong Ancient Village**

Led by local Naxi villagers from Yulong Ancient Village, students will learn its basic overview and history.

- **Naxi Farming Experiences**

Spend a day live as a Naxi person, observing the essential crops and household items for Naxi daily life, From grinding soy milk, feeding horses, herding sheep, to picking vegetables, assist villagers in various farming tasks throughout the day.



- **Danxia Landform**

DanXia is a type of horizontal structural landform. It is characterized by long-term weathering and erosion of red sandstone, resulting in isolated peaks and steep, peculiar rocks. The unique geographical environment has nurtured rich ecological resources.

- **Rock Climbing**

Rockclimbing At Dawn Scenic Area will last 2.5 hours, with a 1:5 ratio of climbing instructors to ensure the safety while enjoying the breathtaking beauty natural.



- **Blue moon Valley Hiking**

The Yulong Snow Mountain in Lijiang is the southernmost large snow mountain in the northern hemisphere. In the Blue Moon Valley at the foot of the snow mountain, one can not only admire the magnificence of the snow-capped peaks but also see the azure lakes in the valley, making it an unmissable attraction in Lijiang.

BBQ in the foot of the snow mountain with delicious Yunan local cuisine
