Curriculum

The secondary school curriculum is divided into two academic programmes - the IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) for students in grades 7 to 10 and the IB Diploma Programme (IBDP) for students in grades 11 and 12.

Middle Years Programme (MYP) Grades 7 to 10

The core subjects in the MYP are Language and Literature (in English or Chinese), Language Acquisition (Chinese, French or Spanish), Mathematics, Sciences, Individuals and Societies, Arts (students specialise in one from grade 9 onwards), Design and Physical Education.

Diploma Programme (DP) Grades 11 and 12

The IB Diploma programme is a two-year course. Students complete six subjects, three at higher level (HL) and three at standard level (SL). As well as selecting one subject from each of the six subject groups, students must successfully complete the core three requirements of the DP: the extended essay, the theory of knowledge (TOK) and creativity, activity and service (CAS).

CIS secondary school graduation requirements

CIS students are provided with the opportunity to pursue the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma and a CIS High School Diploma. In order to earn a CIS High School Diploma, students in grades 9 to 12 must earn a minimum of 25 academic credits and complete the IB core requirements. **Scan the QR code below to view the full diploma requirement details.**



CIS students are awarded a CIS High School diploma by fulfilling graduation requirements as determined by the school and accredited by WASC. The CIS High School diploma is the equivalent of an American High School diploma through IB course work. A student may choose to complete the CIS High School diploma and not pursue the full DP diploma by selecting IB courses at both the SL and HL levels, with the option of earning further credit through VHS Learning. Students may also select to write IB exams for IB course certificates to be formally awarded.
