

# Pre-admission counselling for international students.

## 1. RELEVANT SINGAPORE LAWS:

Relevant Singapore laws include, but are not limited to, immigration requirements, employment, laws on driving, drugs and alcohol abuse, smoking, traffic and littering. If in doubt, please check with the relevant authorities or seek legal counsel.

### Immigration

All international students studying in Singapore must have a valid passport and a student pass from the Immigration and Checkpoint Authority (ICA).

### Employment

International students are not allowed to work in Singapore without a work pass exemption from the Ministry of Manpower (MOM).

### Driving

All drivers must be in possession of a valid Singapore driving license and the vehicle must be insured.

### Drugs

Possession of controlled drugs is presumed to be for trafficking, an offence, which can carry the death penalty.

### Smoking

Smoking in specific public places and indoor restaurants is prohibited.

### Traffic

Jay walking is an offence.

### Littering

Littering, spitting and vandalism (with graffiti) in public areas are serious offences.
